

ARTICLE 217.003 PUBLIC NUDITY

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to make a public display of nudity or to participate in the act popularly referred to as "STREAKING" in any place frequented by the general public, whether it be a public street or roadway or privately owned property within the City of Mabank, Texas. Any person convicted of violating this provision shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and each violation shall constitute a separate offense.

ARTICLE 243.001 SEXUAL ORIENTED BUSINESS

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful within the city limits of Mabank, Texas, to operate or maintain the type of business or other establishment generally known as a "sexually oriented business" as defined by Section 243.002 of the Texas Local Government Code.


SECTION II.

Whoever shall be found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor, and each day of such violation shall be deemed a separate offense.

ARTICLE 243.001a NUDITY DISPLAYED

It shall be unlawful for any person to display for sale any magazine, or other periodical, with pictures, or any other graphic displays, of the nude human body visible to the public when such display for sale shall be located within one thousand (1,000) feet of any church or school within the City of Mabank, Texas. Any person convicted of violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class C Misdemeanor and each day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

ORDINANCE NO. 4-2-74

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PUBLIC DISPLAY OF NUDITY OR (STREAKING) UPON ANY PUBLIC PLACE, STREET, ALLEY, PARK OR OTHER PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MABANK, TEXAS. PROVIDING A PENALTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to make a public display of nudity or to participate in the act popularly referred to as (STREAKING) in any place frequented by the general public, whether it be a public street or roadway or privately owned property within the City of Mabank, Texas.

Section 2. Any person convicted of violating the provision of Section 1. above shall be fined at least \$25.00 but not more than \$200.00 and each violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. Since an emergency exists for the protection of property and welfare of the community, this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.
